What is the Delaware County PRIDE Team? We are a performance-based team comprised of high school leaders who spread our commitment to an alcohol, tobacco, and drug-free lifestyle through interactive presentations which use a variety of talents including, dance, skits, instruments, tumbling, vocals, public speaking, drawing, etc. to help enhance our drug-free messages at school and community events. Our team is sponsored by the Delaware County Prevention Council, a 501c3 non-profit organization, whose mission is to plan, strengthen, and coordinate community efforts in the areas of alcohol and drug prevention, treatment and law enforcement.

Objectives: The overall objectives of the Delaware County PRIDE Team are:

- Empowerment
- Leadership
- Commitment to advocate for being alcohol, tobacco, and drug-free
- Build awareness and support for peers and elementary students in Delaware County for being alcohol, tobacco and drug-free

Time Commitment: The Delaware County PRIDE Team meets weekly on Sunday's during August, September and October usually from 2:00 pm - 4:00 pm (sometimes a little longer) to prepare for our annual Red Ribbon Campaign. November-May we meet one or two Sunday's per month from 2:00 pm - 4:00 pm location to be determined. PRIDE Team members must maintain a 70% or higher attendance/participation record to remain an active member of the Delaware County PRIDE Team. COVID-19 has changed these requirements over the past year. All of this will be flexible as the COVID-19 issues continue to evolve.

Red Ribbon Week: Red Ribbon Week is one of the main events that the Delaware County PRIDE Team participates in. The annual Red Ribbon Community Event will take place this year. The date, place, and time has not been determined yet.

Team Fees: Team fees are \$100.00 for the year. Half of the fees must be paid by August 1, 2021 and the other half by October 1, 2021. A limited number of scholarships may be available.
